As required in Article VII, Section 7.2 of the Bylaws of Westchester Water Works Conference, Inc., I herewith submit the Annual Treasurer's Report for the Fiscal Year 2022. The 2022 Fiscal Year runs from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

The Conference, as of December 31, 2022, had a total fund balance of \$47,521.52, as compared to \$47,632.87 for 2021 annual meeting. Conference funds are deposited in two accounts: a checking account and a Business Money Market Plus account, both with TD Bank. The Money Market balance is \$36,053.86 and is invested as an interest-bearing account for the scholarship fund as approved by the Conference Board of Directors on August 25, 1994.

This year's revised budget, as of December 31, 2022, does indicate an income-to-expense estimate to be positive approximately \$382.00. This was the result of resuming in-person meetings and education workshops.

During 2022, the membership list was reviewed and checked in the Excel spreadsheet and Constant Contact show 357 members; however, in 2022 only 203 paid.
